## How is the qualification structured?

All ILM qualifications are awarded by the City and Guilds of London Institute, founded in 1878 and incorporated by Royal Charter. The ILM Level 7 Certificate / Diploma for Coaching Supervisors is registered on Ofqual's Regulated Qualifications Framework. There are three units of study:

- 1. Understanding the Principles and Practice of Effective Coaching Supervision of Coaches**  
(One written assignment.)
- 2. Undertaking a Period of Coaching Supervision** - submission of a detailed portfolio of evidence for 20/60 hours supervision, plus your reflective learning log and other supporting documents. 4/8 hours of supervision of supervision is required and not included in your fees (further guidance available). Certificate and Diploma figures shown
- 3. Reflecting on Your Ability to Perform Effectively as a Coaching Supervisor of Coaches** a discussion of your supervision evidence and experiences, to be submitted as part of the portfolio

## Enrolment and payment

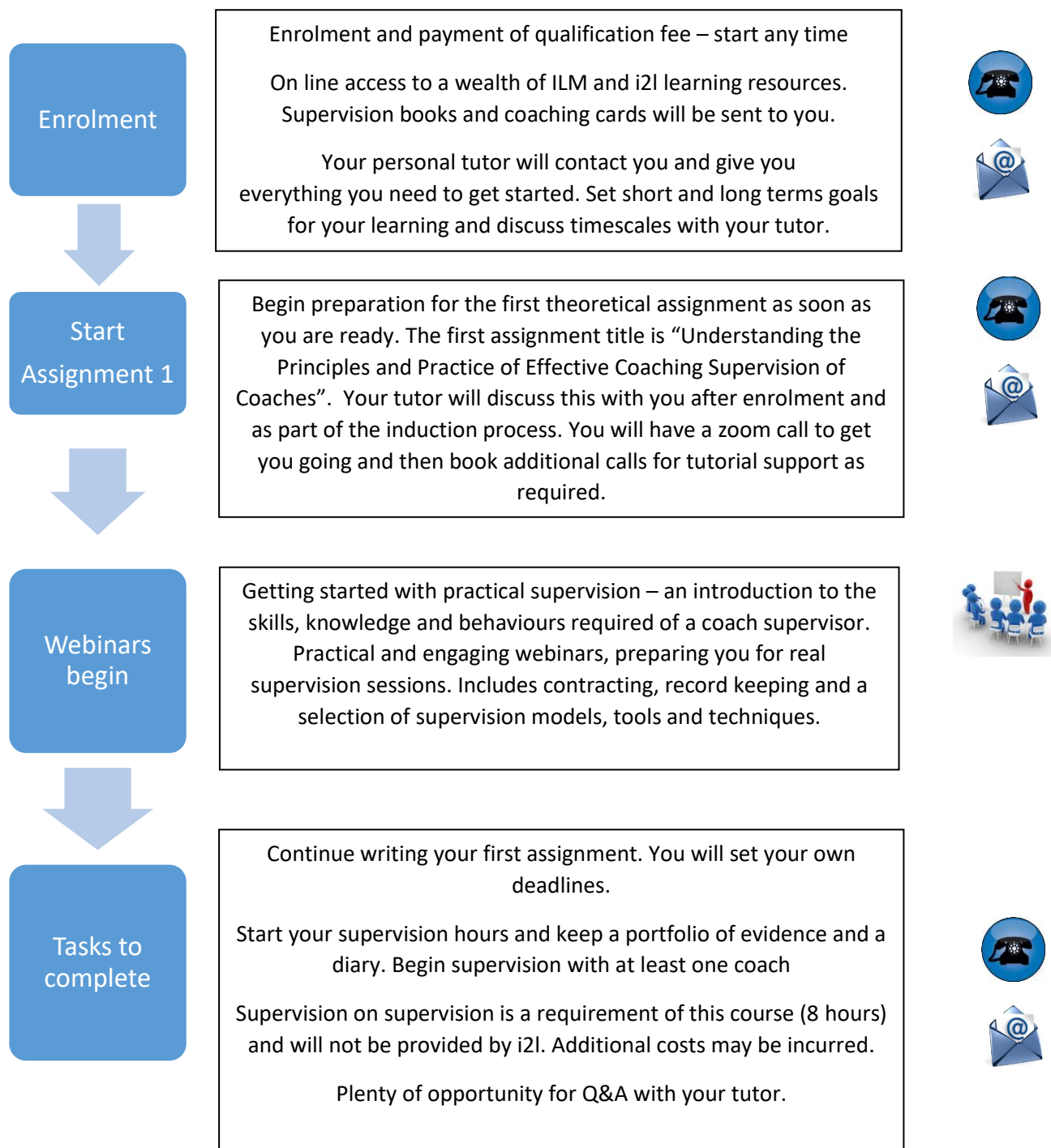
**Are there any entry requirements? You must be an experienced coach.** There is an application process for you to complete which details the prior coaching experience and evidence required. You must also have access to supervisees to complete the practical supervision work. The course is a post-graduate level qualification and includes independent research of theory and best practice, reflection and preparation of substantial written work. If you are not sure if the course is the right academic level for you, call Clare on 07977 362787.

**How do I enrol?** We will send you an application enrolment form. You can start the course any time and you will join other learners for the virtual webinars and co-supervision. You set the pace. Some take less time, some take more, depending on work commitments. Work at a pace that suits your lifestyle and you have one year to complete (or less). No waiting time for certification after work assessed work has passed.

**What are the payment options?** You have the option to pay the full fee in advance or set up a payment

## How is the training structured?

In order to achieve the ILM Level 7 qualification, you will undertake private study supported by virtual workshops and webinars. You will complete three written assignments, including 60 hours of supervision and a reflective portfolio. You will set your own pace for completion of the assignments and practical supervision sessions. Your personal tutor will be there to guide and support you every step of the way.
